


Blanket Guidelines

Fleece “no sew” or “tie” blankets are a most welcome item to send to our troops. It is very easy to prepare a blanket once you have the supplies.

1. Gather or cut two fleece rectangles. Fleece rectangles should be larger than 45”x65” for maximum warmth and comfort.
2. Place wrong sides together. Cut one 5 ½” square from each corner of both fleece pieces. Do this on each corner.
3. Cut 5 ½ -inches into fleece at 1 ½ inch intervals around all sides of both top and bottom.



NO knotting needed!!!

Instead of knotting your blanket, try this method. Your blankets will lay nice and flat and never pucker or bunch up!

- Cut a small slit about ½” long through both pieces of fleece, at the base of each strip. The easiest way to do this is to fold the fringe pieces over and cut about ¼” into the fold. DO NOT try to poke the scissors through the fleece.
- Pick up the two pieces of cut fringe and thread them both through the slit from the front to the back. Pull through.
- Your fringe should look like this!
- Roll blanket tightly, tie with a ribbon.
